BIOGRAPHY

Architect Andrew Benko was born in Hungary and trained in Italy. Benko wrote newspaper articles on the planning of houses in the postwar period. He also co-authored, with Rex Lloyd, the book *Replanning our towns and countryside* in 1949 based on a series of lectures they had given at the Workers Education Association (WEA) in Adelaide. Andrew Benko was a member of the South Australian Institute of Architects and a Registered Architect under the Architects Act of South Australia. He was married to Nancy Benko (nee Atkinson) eminent microbiologist. Andrew Benko died in 1997.
